

**Annual General Body meeting of *SHRADDHA*

Annual General Body meeting of *SHRADDHA* was held in the Registered office at Cuttack on the 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2023. Dr Sanjay Kumar Panda, President presided over the meeting. Shri Surendra Kumar Patra, Vice president, Shri Bani Ranjan Das, Secretary, Smt Suvra Shibani treasurer and other members participated in the discussion. After discussion, following resolutions were passed unanimously.

- Minutes of the discussions held in the last meeting of the General Body held on 24<sup>th</sup> April 2022 and action taken thereupon (gist indicated in annexure V) were discussed and the minutes were confirmed.
- Position of statutory compliances relating to registration under sections 1A and 80 G of the Income tax Act, *Darpan* portal of NITI Aayog and for getting CSR fund as per guidelines of the Ministry of Corporate Affairs were noted and the concerned members were thanked,
- The Annual report of the society for the year 2022-23 was discussed and accepted. The loans, availed for meeting immediate requirements will be settled on getting the reimbursement form NABARD.
- The Accounts of the society for the year 2022-23 was discussed and accepted. It was decided to refer the accounts to Shri N K Acharya CA for audit.
- The budget of the society for the year 2023-24 was discussed and accepted.
- Shri Sanjib Kumar Behera, Joint Secretary has expressed certain difficulties for working as Joint secretary on personal grounds. It was resolved to accept his resignation and appoint Shri Suvendu Tripathy, member to work as Joint secretary with immediate effect for remaining part of the term of the present committee.
- It was resolved to complete the remaining components of the LEDP sanctioned by NABARD and move NABARD for sanction of another project for weaving and design diversification.
- It was resolved to seek funding from corporate under Corporate Social Responsibility(CSR) initiatives.
- It was resolved to give particular stress on empowering the weavers to produce with quality, new color and new products and to connect with the customers on digital media, which will increase their earnings substantially.
- It was resolved to provide support to the producer weavers with health, education, environment related issues in conformity with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG).
